The Organization

Aflatoun International is a non-profit organisation, which offers social, financial & entrepreneurship education to children and young people worldwide, empowering them to make a positive change for a more equitable world. Aflatoun programmes inspire children to discover their talents and put them to use, to stand up for their rights and those of their communities through active learning and problem-solving. They learn how to save, how to budget, and how to set up social and financial enterprises that benefit themselves, their families and their communities. - Excellent analytic, written, communication, interpersonal and presentation skills.
- Proficient use of MS Office and databases.
- Intern/Volunteer must have the right to reside in the Netherlands. Visa sponsorship is not possible.
